Introduction

The CT-HDVD-EXT-RG-IR195 extends HDMI signal using coaxial cable.

Benefits from using the CT-HDVD-EXT-RG-IR195:

- 1) The CT-HDVD-EXT-RG-IR195 transmits 1080P across distances up to 195 feet.
- The CT-HDVD-EXT-RG-IR195 has the ability to perform signal buffering and amplification. Transmitter units can be daisy chained together for distances over 195 feet.
- 3) The unit has IR pass-thru capability allowing remote control functionality from a receiver location.

Connections and Operations

- Connect the HDMI input source (such as HD-DVD, video game unit, STB etc.) to the CT-HDVD-EXT-RG-IR195 TX.
- Connect a COAX cable from the COAX output of the CT-HDVD-EXT-RG-IR195 TX to the COAX input of the CT-HDVD-EXT-RG-IR195 RX.
- 3) Connect the HDMI display (Figure as HD-LCD, HD-DLP) to the RX unit.
- 4) Connect the IR TX emitter unit into the CT-HDVD-EXT-RG-IR195IR TX; Connect the IR RX target uNIT into the CT-HDVD-EXT-RG-IR195.
- 5) Connect the IR RX UNIT into the CT-HDVD-EXT-RG-IR195 RX; Connect the IR TX UNIT into the CT-HDVD-EXT-RG-IR195 IR TX.

<u>Note2:</u> The UNIT will use the embedded 1080P-5.1 EDID when the DIP switch is in this mode. The EDID will be 1080P video and 5.1 audio.

Note3: The UNIT will use the embedded 1080P-7.1 EDID when the DIP switch is in this mode. The EDID will be 1080P video and 7.1 audio.

<u>Note4:</u> Auto copy the EDID data to the input port. The unit will copy the EDID data from the device which is connected to the CT-HDVD-EXT-RG-IR195.

• Provided Service

- Damage Requiring service: The unit should be serviced by qualified service personnel if:

Warranty

CABLETRONIX. (the "Company") warrants to the Original Purchaser that the item purchased is free from defects in workmanship or material under normal use. This warranty starts on the date of shipment of the hardware to the Original Purchaser.

During the warranty period, the Company agrees to repair or replace, at its sole option, without charge to Original Purchaser, any defective component. To obtain service, the Original Purchaser must return the item to the Company properly packaged for shipping. All defective products must be returned to the Company within thirty (30) days of failure. Products must be returned with a description of the failure and Return Merchandise Authorization (RMA) number supplied by the Company. To receive a RMA number and a return shipping address on where to deliver the hardware, call 610-429-1821. The shipping, and insurance charges incurred in shipping to the Company will be paid by Original Purchaser, and all risk for the hardware shall remain with the Original Purchaser until such time as Company takes receipt of the hardware. Upon receipt, the Company will promptly repair or replace the defective unit, and then return said unit to Original Purchaser, shipping prepaid. The Company may use reconditioned or like-new parts or units, at its sole option, when repairing any hardware. Repaired products shall carry the same amount of outstanding warranty as from original purchase. Any claim under the warranty must include dated proof of purchase or invoice. In any event, the Company's liability for defective hardware is limited to repairing or replacing the hardware.
