Assembling The Base

1. Assemble left and right bases to middle support using washer plates and hardware as shown.
2. Tighten all screws with a Hex key.

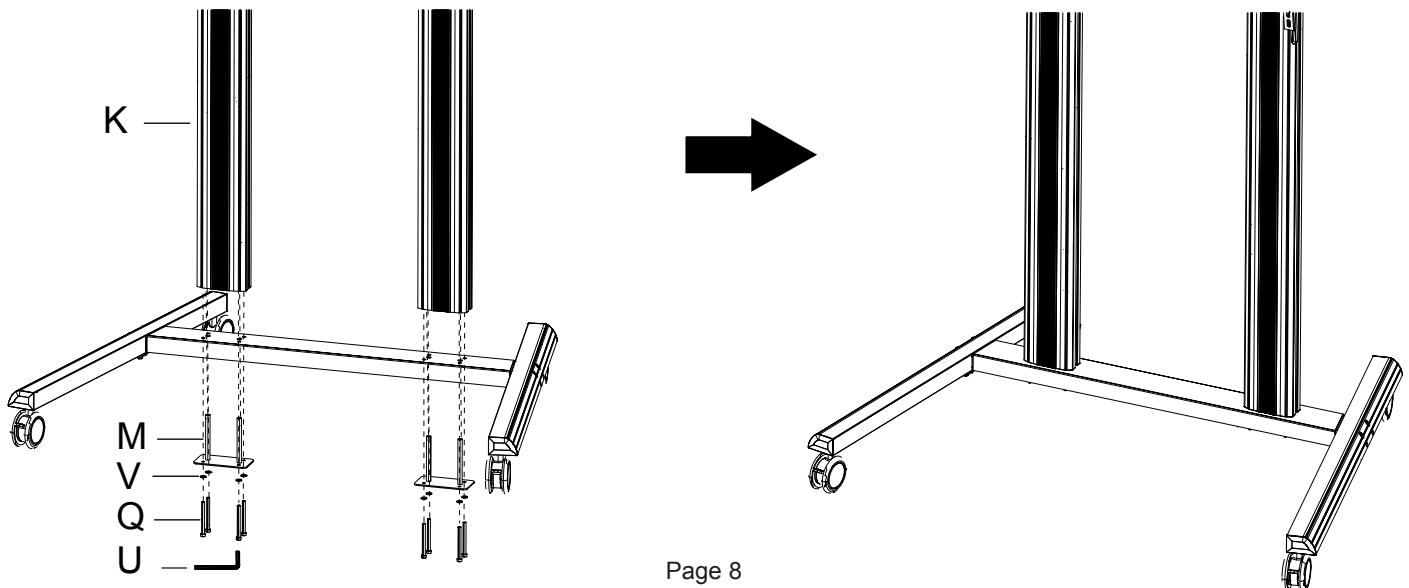


NOTE: With the brake wheels facing forward.



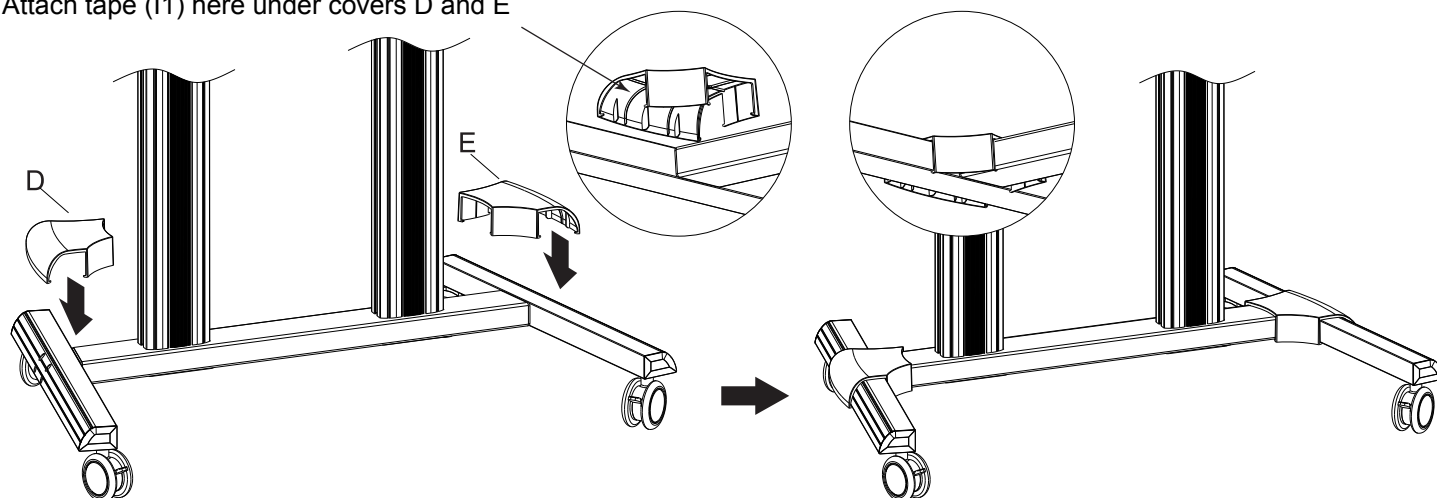
Attaching The Column To The Base

1. Attach column to assembled base using the connection plate, secure them with appropriate screws.
NOTE: Lock brakes on casters to avoid any sudden movements during installation.



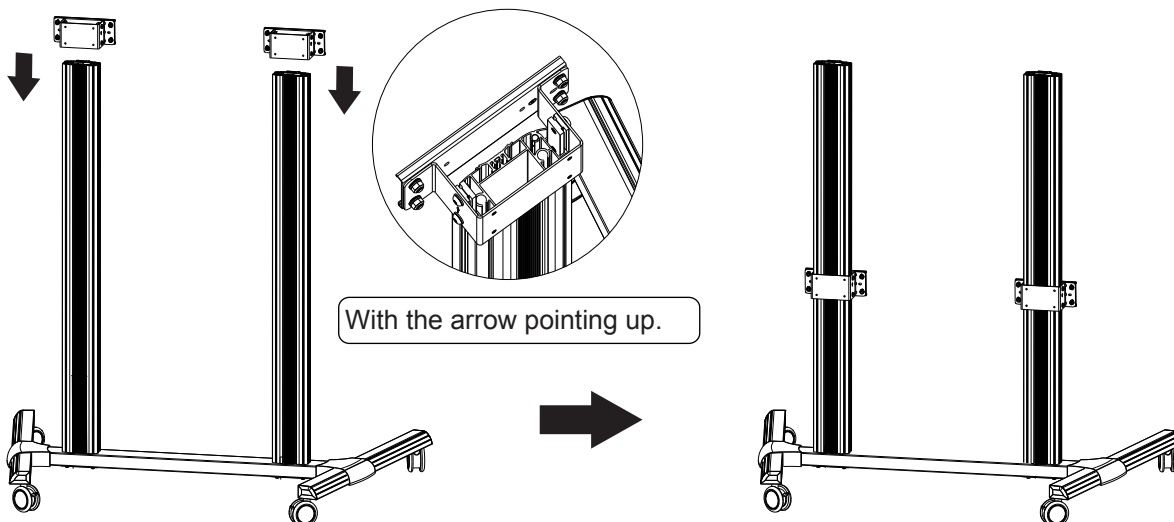
Installing The Covers

Attach tape (I1) here under covers D and E

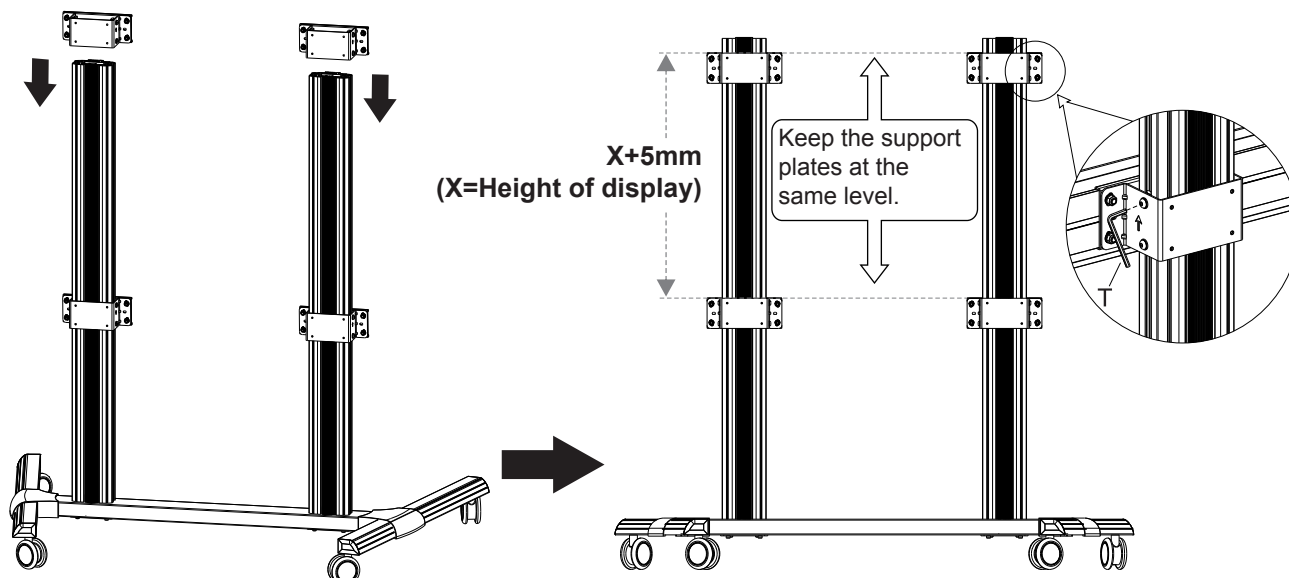


Installing The Support Plates

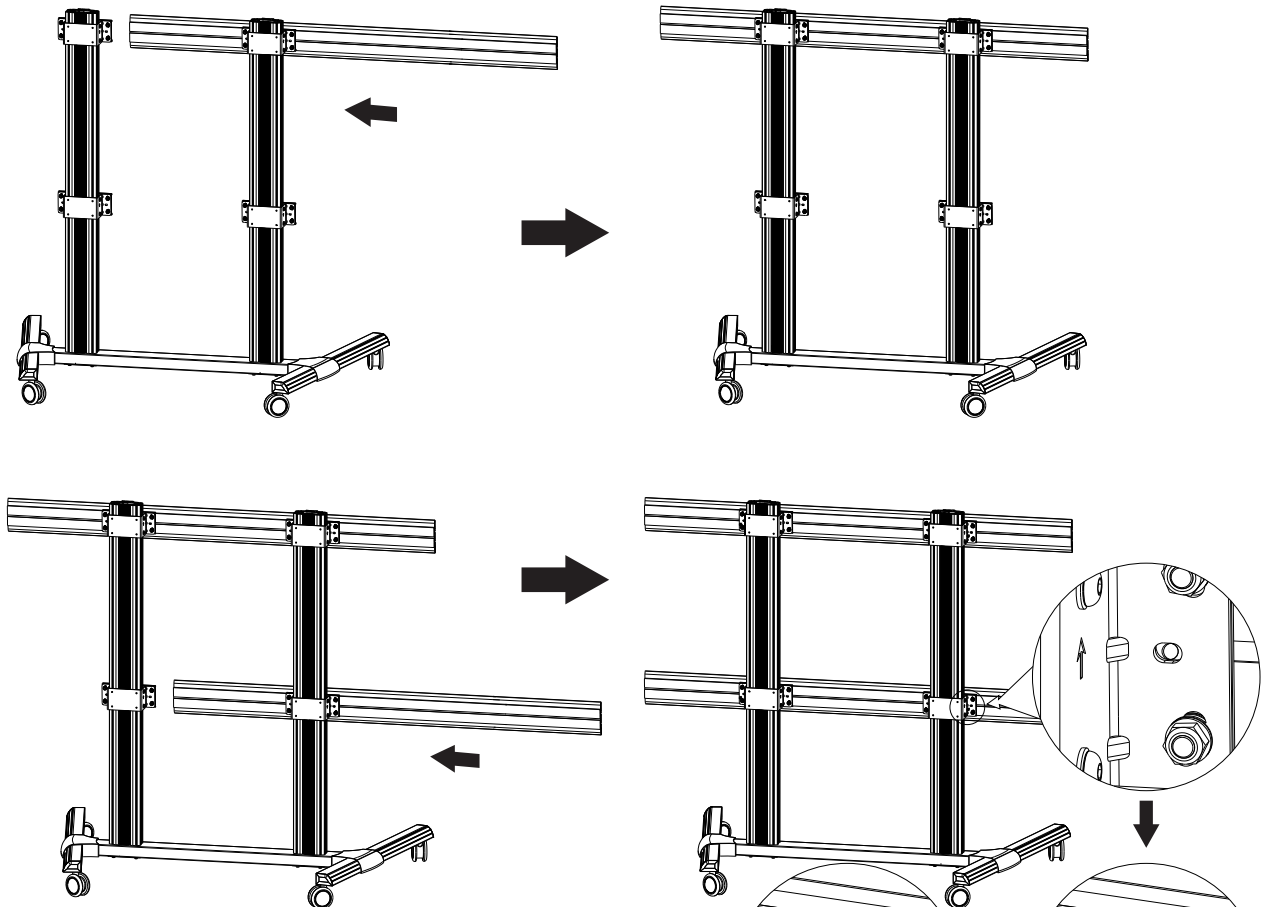
1. Insert the support plates into the columns along the column rails respectively.



2. Tighten all screws to secure the support plate.



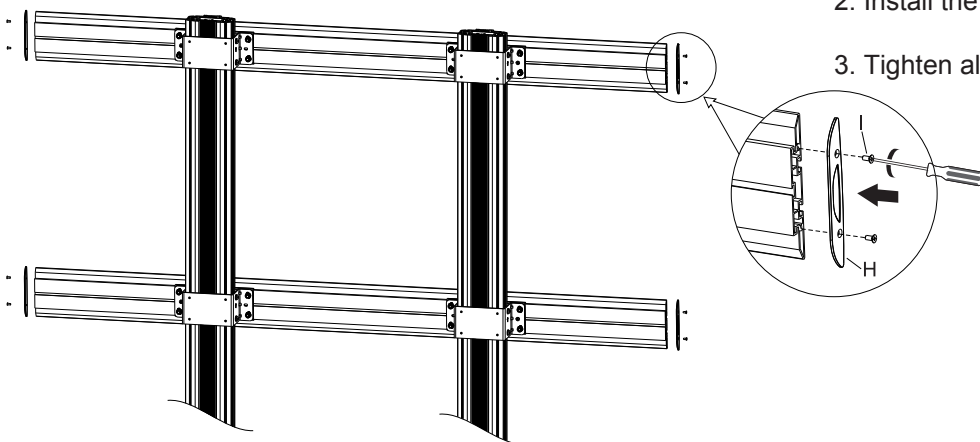
Installing The Universal Plate



1. Insert the universal plates to the support plates and align the holes in the universal plates with the holes in the support plates.

2. Install the screw into either of two holes.

3. Tighten all screws but do not over tighten!

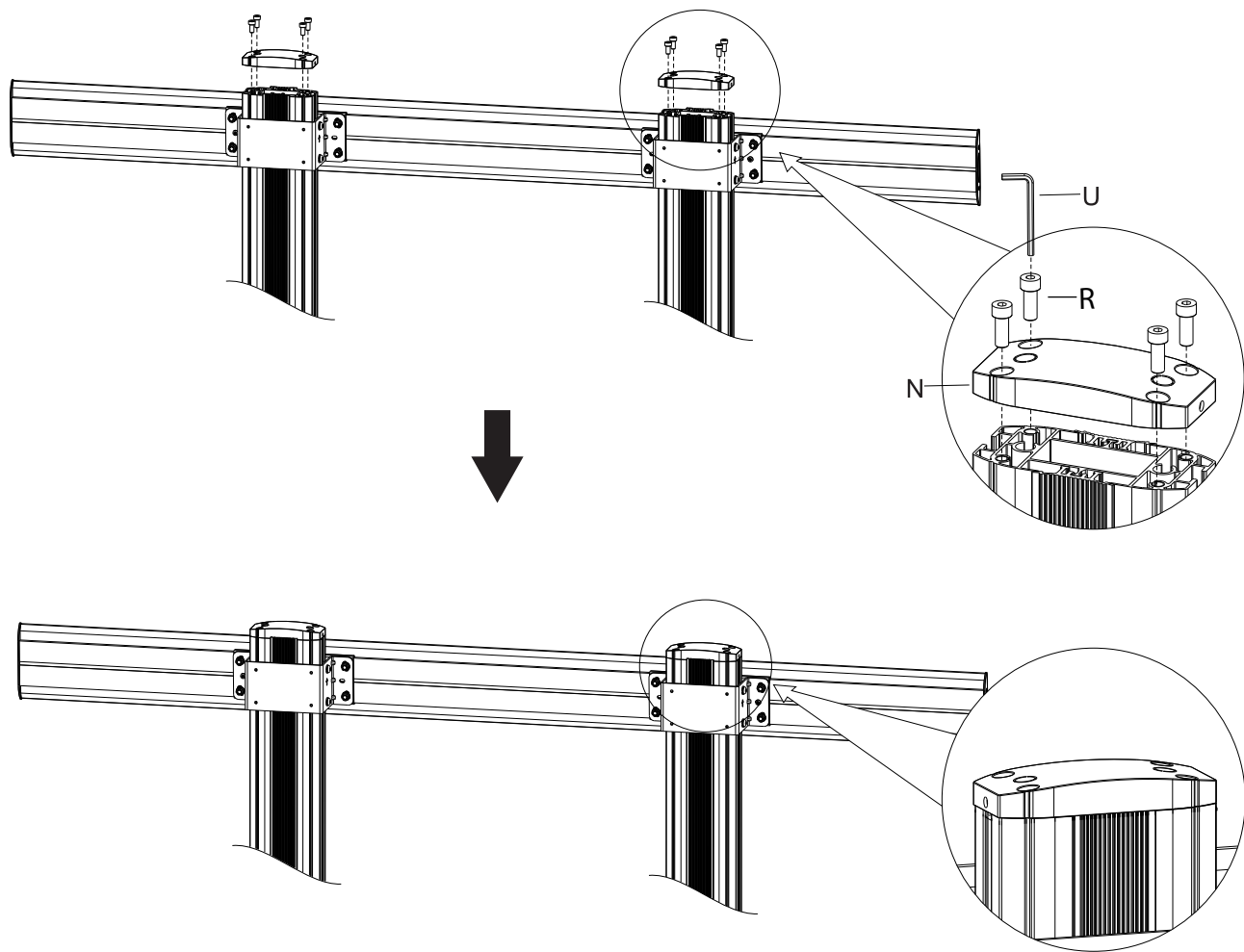


4. Attach the two plastic covers to both ends of the universal plates using the screws and tighten all screws to secure.

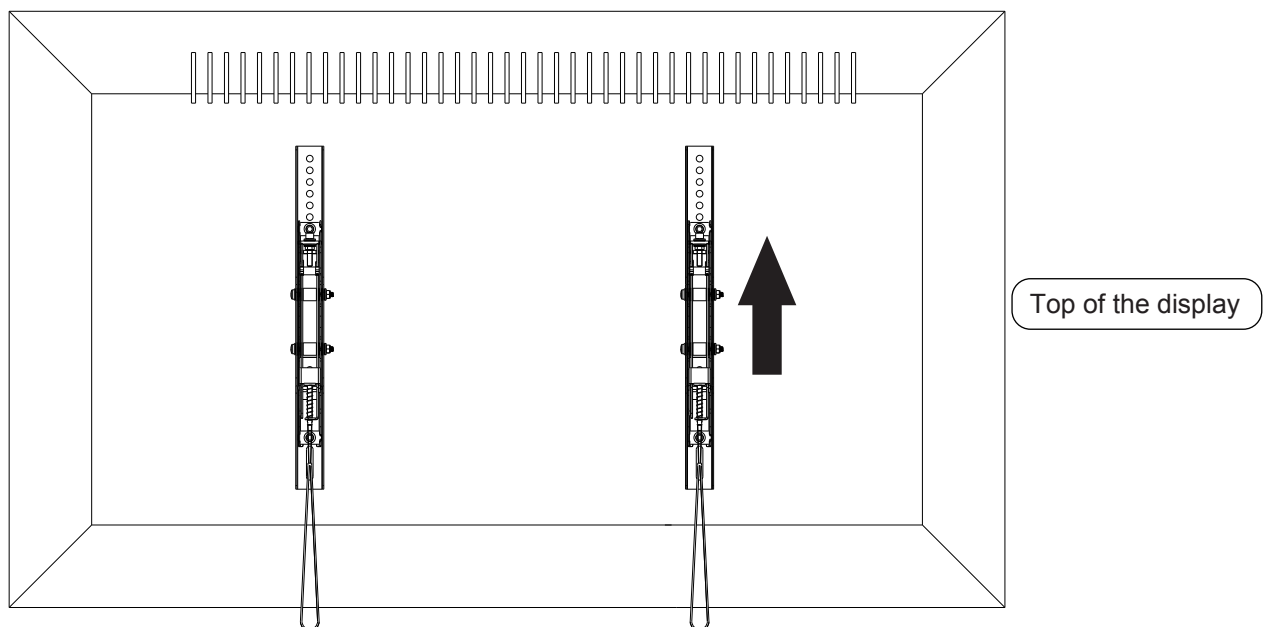
NOTE: The other two plastic covers are installed in the same way.

Installing The Top Covers

1. Attach the top covers to the columns using the appropriate screws. Tighten all screws with an Hex key.

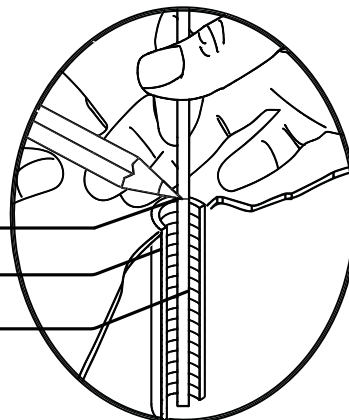
Selecting The Mounting Hardware To Attach Brackets To Flat Panel

- 1) Identify the correct diameter screw for the flat panel threaded inserts. The correct screws should thread easily and not pull out when tension is applied.
- 2) To determine proper screw length, insert thread depth indicator into a threaded insert on the flat panel.
- 3) Mark the thread depth indicator 1/8" above the depth of the threaded insert.
- 4) Select a screw length that is closest to the mark made on the thread depth indicator.

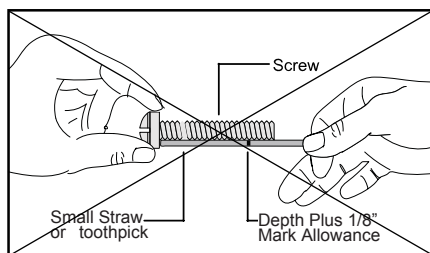
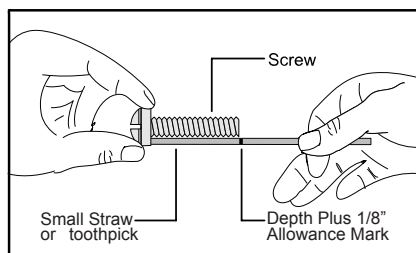
Mark 1/8" Above Depth

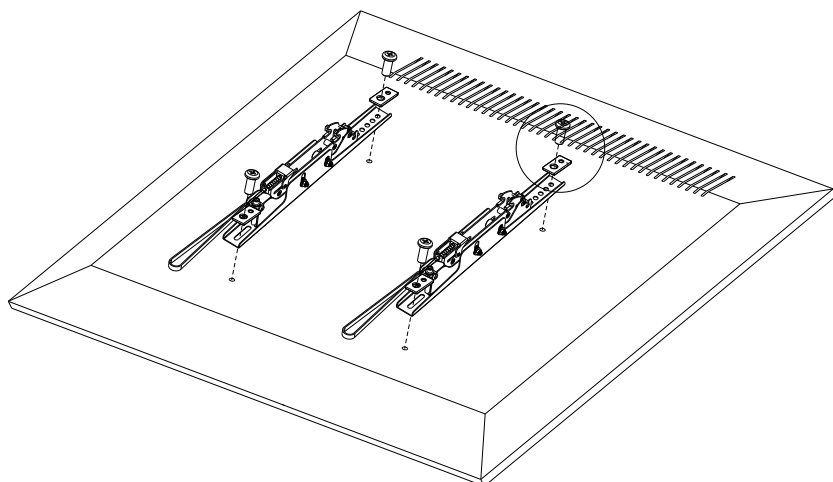
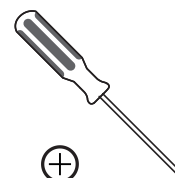
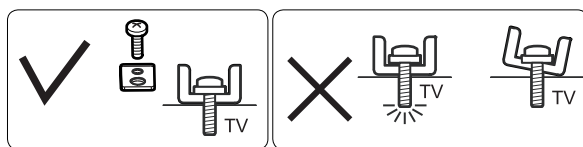
Thread Depth Indicator

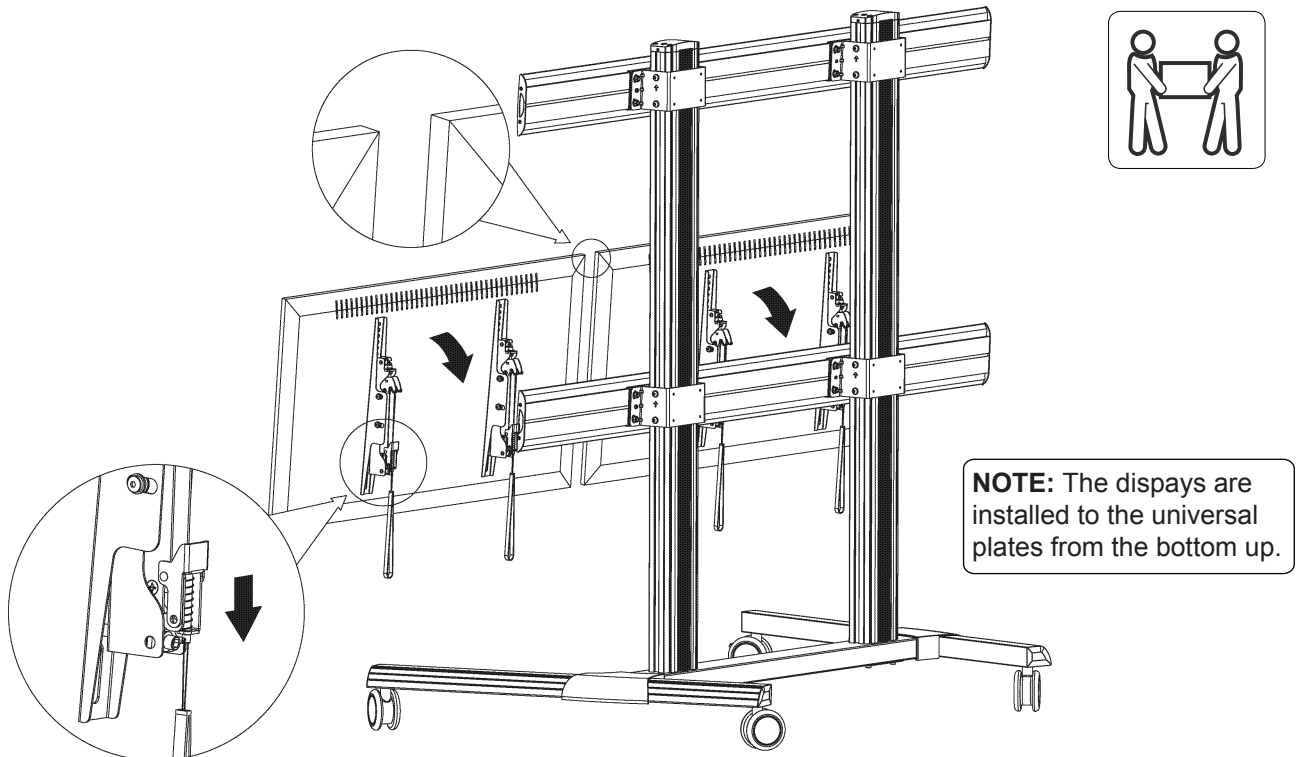
NOTE: Choose the appropriate screws, washers and spacers (if necessary) according to the type of display.

- Screw the adapter brackets onto the displays.

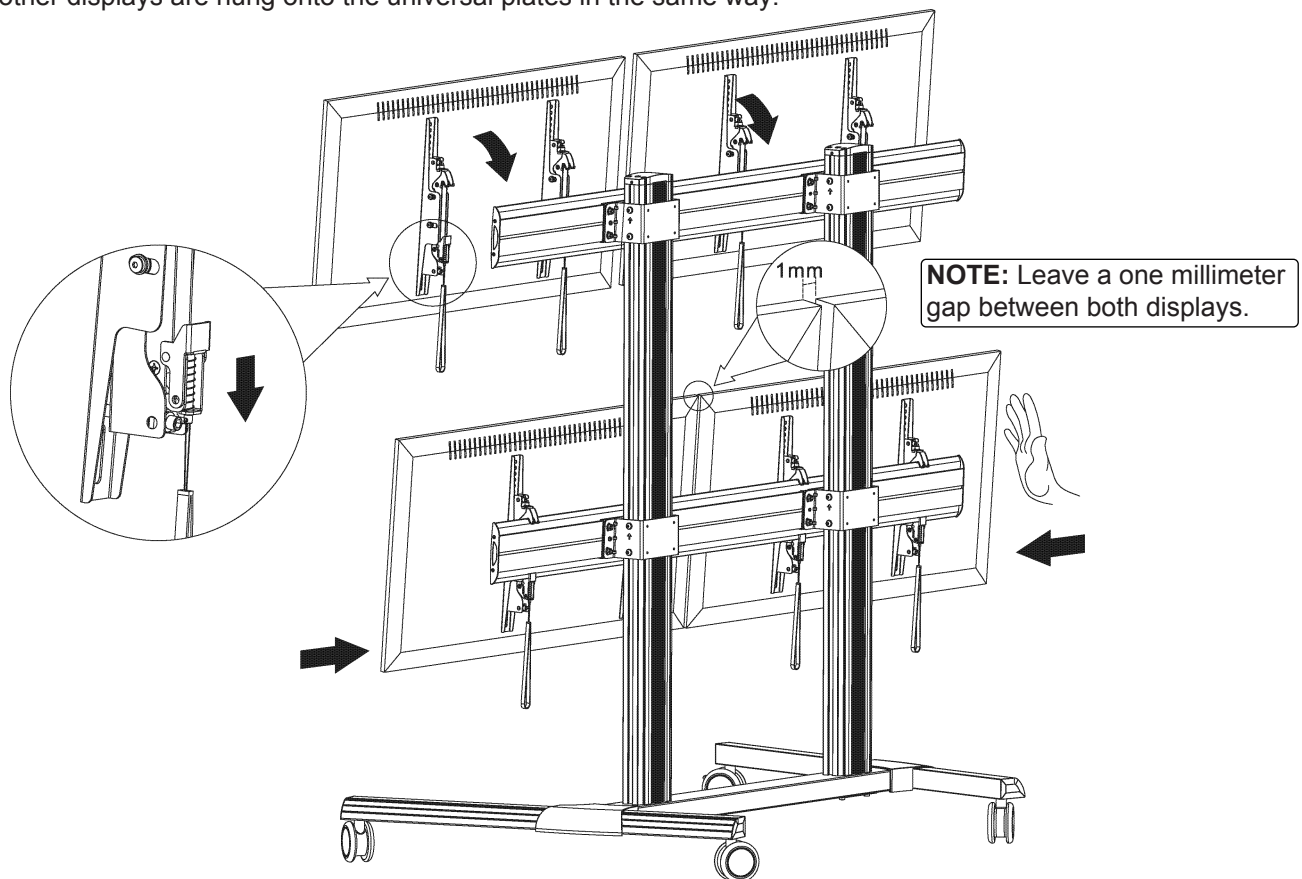
 Tighten all screws but do not over-tighten.

Hooking The Displays Onto The Universal Plates

1. Insert support plate along column rails to the required position and tighten all screws with Hex key.



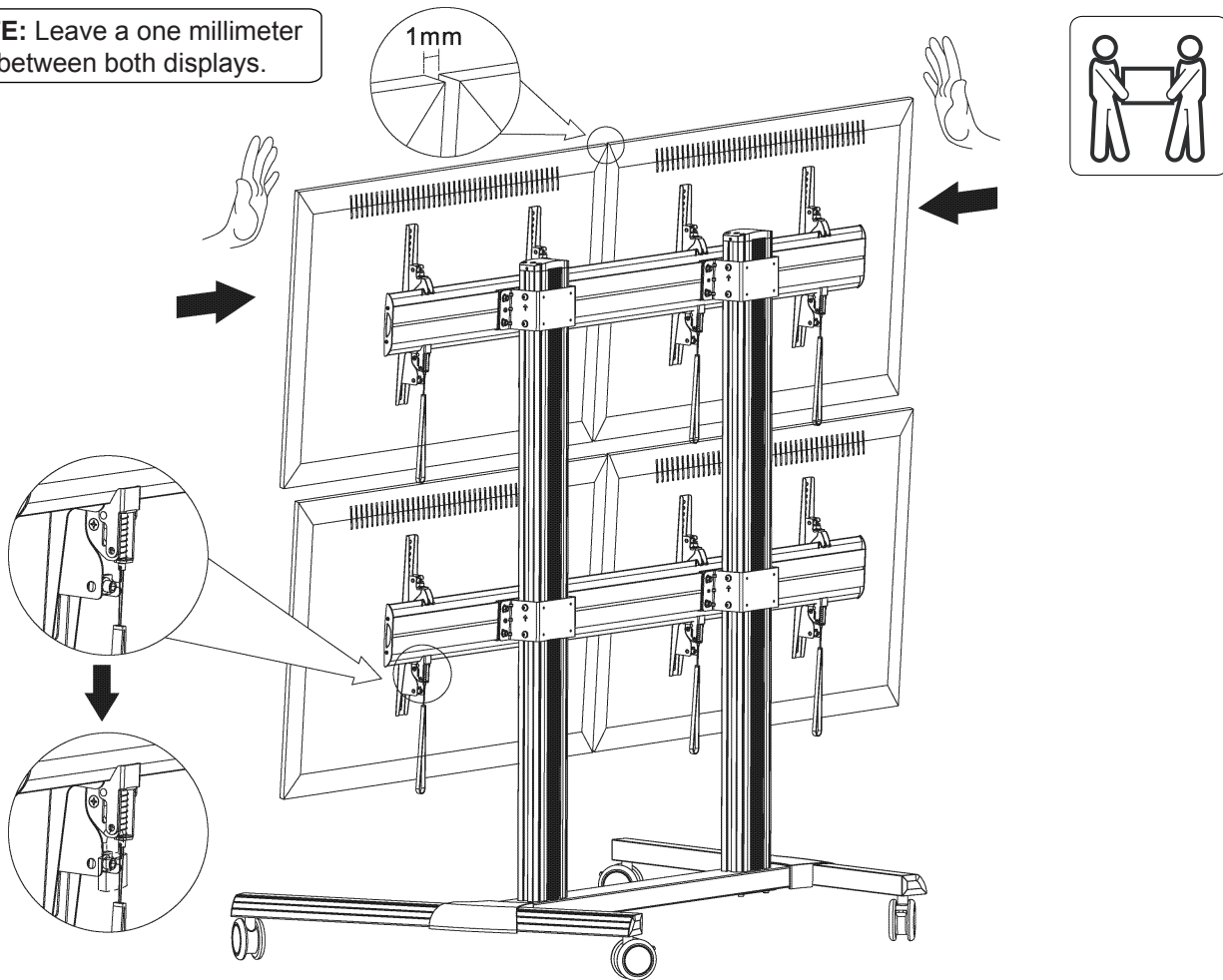
2. Lift the display carefully and pull downward two straps at the same time, then hook the adapter brackets to the universal plates. Fasten the adapter brackets to the universal plate by releasing the straps.
3. The other displays are hung onto the universal plates in the same way.



Hooking The Displays Onto The Universal Plates (Continued)

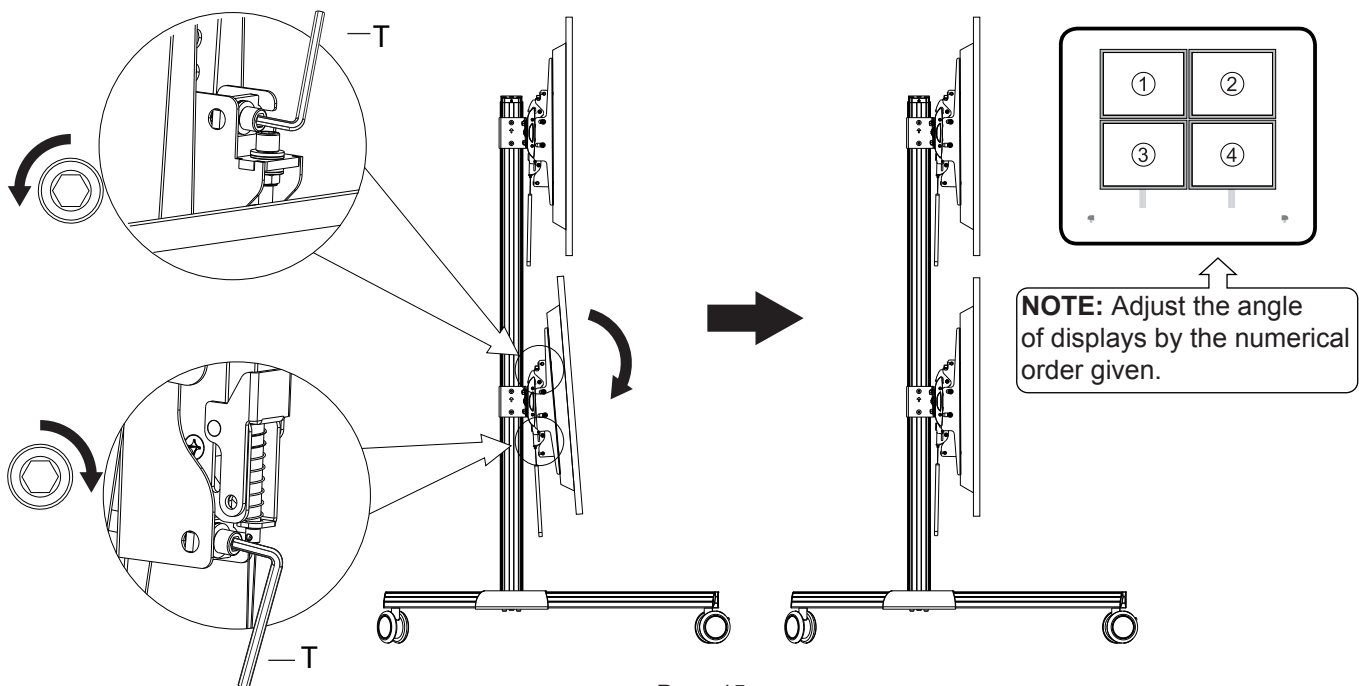
1. Use the padlocks to prevent the displays from being stolen (The padlocks are included).

NOTE: Leave a one millimeter gap between both displays.



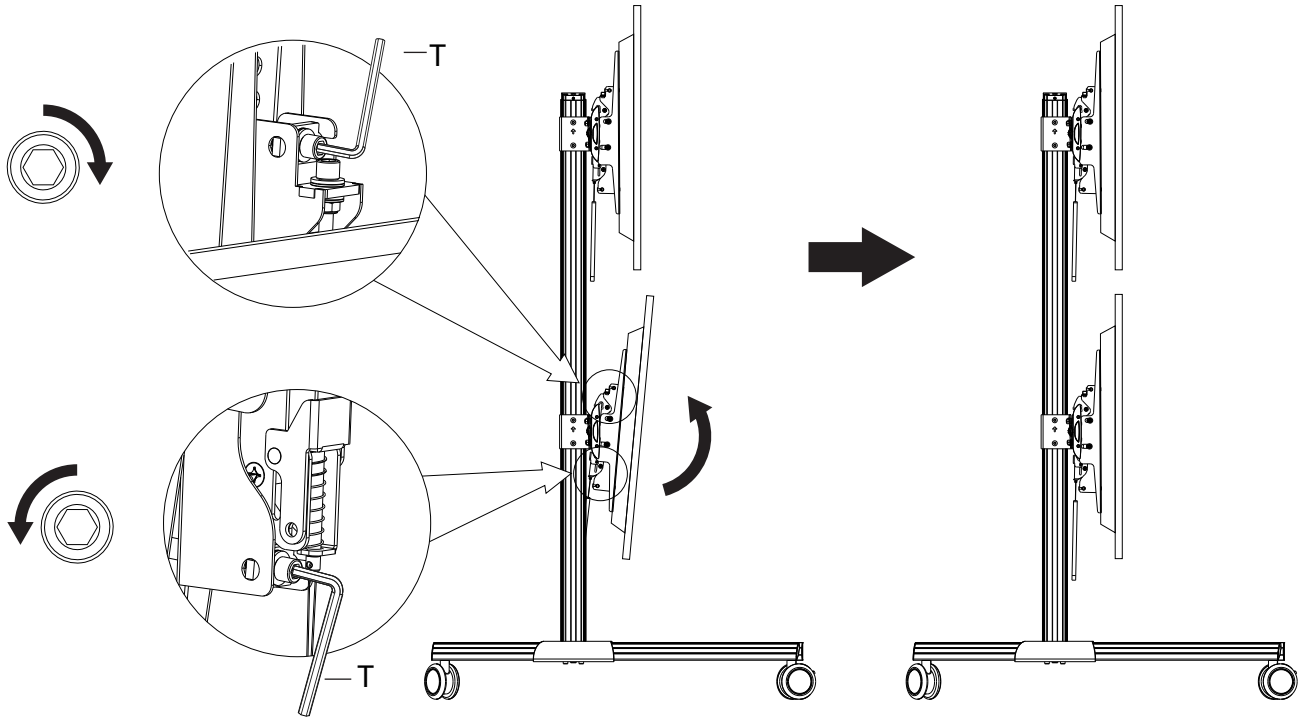
Micro Adjustments

1. If the display is uptilted, rotate the adjustment screws as shown in figure below.

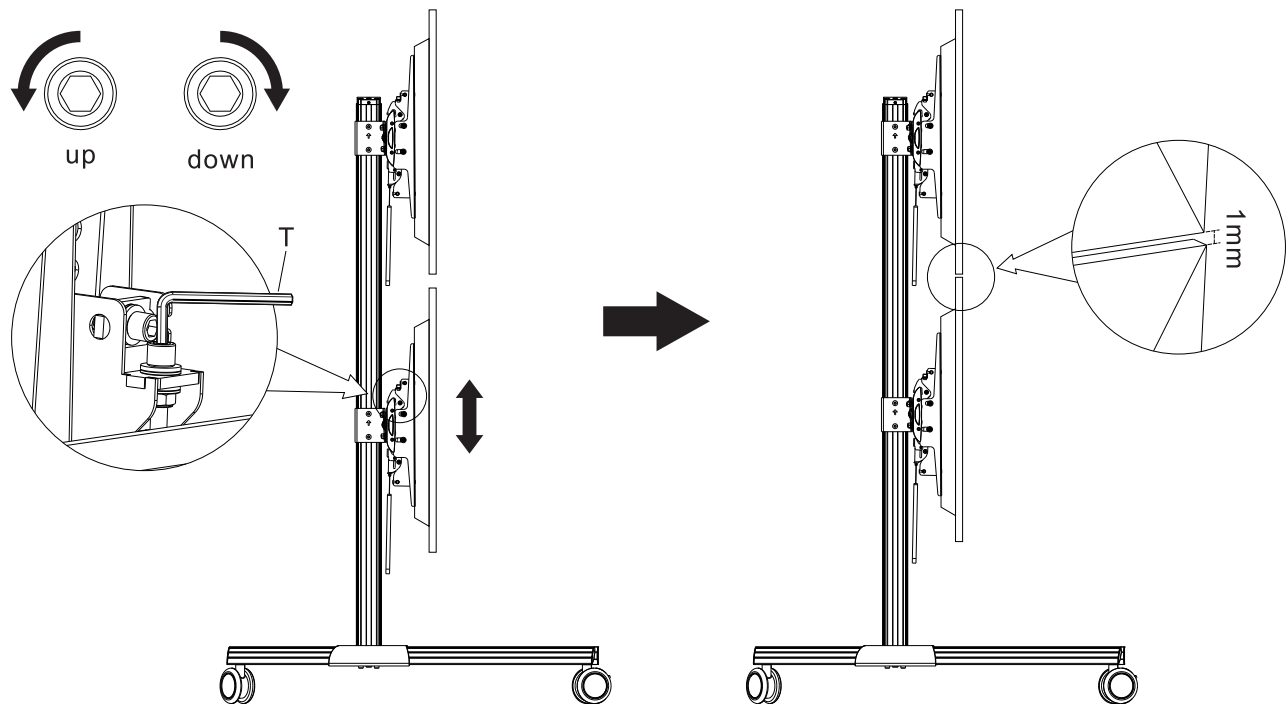


Micro Adjustments (Continued)

1. Rotate the adjustment screws as shown in figure to make a one millimeter gap left between the upper and lower displays.

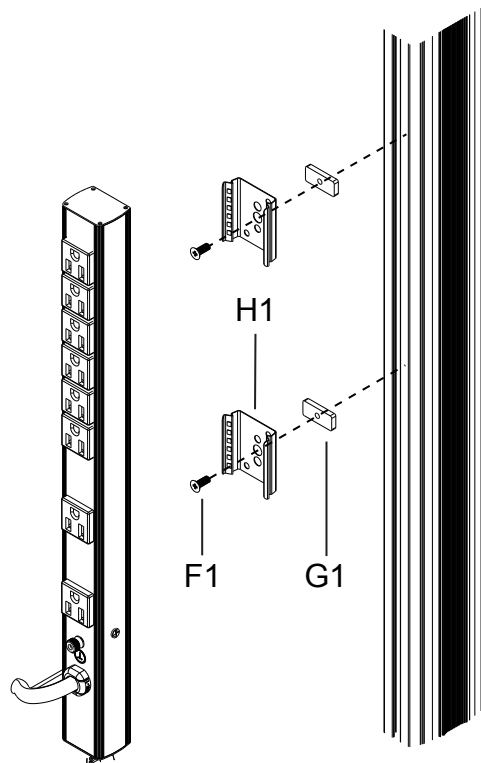


2. If the display is tilted down, rotate the adjustment screws as shown in figure below..



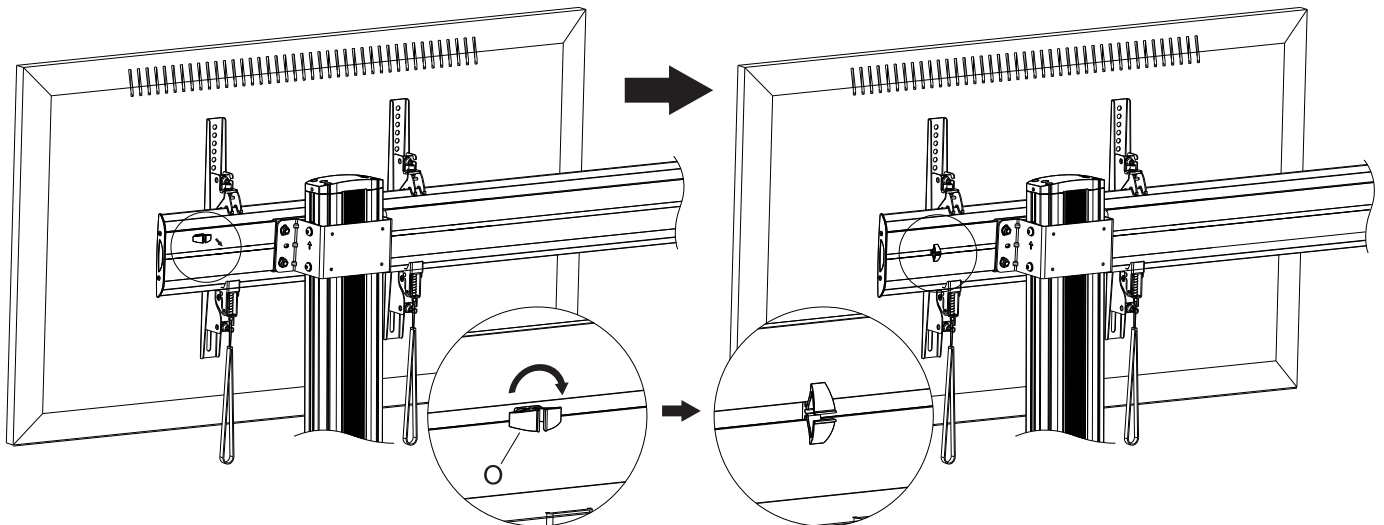
Installing The Power Strip

1. Attach power strip brackets to desired column at a suitable location using screws and oval nuts. Tighten all screws with a Phillips screwdriver and snap power strip into brackets to complete installation.

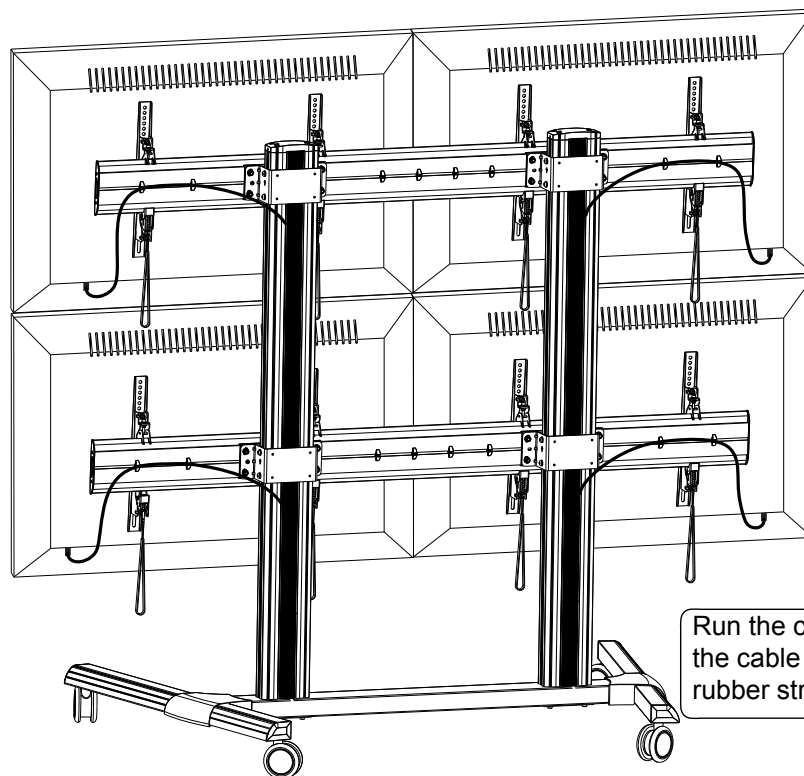


Cable Management

1. Insert the cable clamps horizontally into the plate slots, then turn the cable clamps to the vertical to secure them.
