

Quick Start Guide



Insert the battery.



Insert a card.
Two cards can be inserted.



Attach the lens.

Align it with the red dot.



Set the lens focus mode switch to <AF>.



Set the power switch to <ON>.

Set the shooting mode to <P>. Press the <MODF> butter

Press the <MODE> button and turn the <a>() dial to select <**P**>.



Focus the subject.

Aim the viewfinder center over the subject and press the shutter button halfway to autofocus.



Take the picture.

Press the shutter button completely to take the picture.




View the image.

The captured image will be displayed for 2 sec. on the LCD monitor.






Menu Operations







ISO: ISO Speed



- Press the <ISO> button, then turn the <a>log
 ISO 100 to 51200 can be set in
- 1/3-stop increments.
- When "A" is selected, the ISO speed is set automatically. When you press the shutter button halfway, the ISO speed setting is displayed.

AF: AF Mode



- Set the lens focus mode switch to <AF>
- Press the <AF DRIVE> button, then turn the < > dial.



- ONE SHOT (One-Shot AF): For still subjects AISERVO (AI Servo AF): For moving subjects
- Instead of pressing the shutter button halfway, AF is also possible by pressing the <AF-ON > button.

AF Area Selection Mode



- Press the < ==> button. Look through the viewfinder and press the <M-Fn> button.
- Each time you press the <M-Fn> button, the AF area selection mode changes.

□ AF Point Selection




Press the < > button, then look through the viewfinder.



- The AF point selection will change in the direction you tilt the <♣>>. If you press <♣>> straight down, the center AF point (or center Zone) will be selected.
- The < >> dial selects an AF point in the horizontal direction, and the <>> dial selects an AF point in the vertical direction (toggles between zones in Zone

Metering Mode



- Press the <③•52> button, then turn the < >> dial.
- S Evaluative metering: Standard metering mode
- Partial metering: Approx. 6.5% at center
- Spot metering: Approx. 2.5% at center
- Center-weighted average metering:

Brightness metered at the center and averaged for the entire scene

When spot metering is set, multi-spot metering is possible with the M-Fn > button.

™ Exposure Compensation



Decreased exposure ONE ISO 100

Standard exposure index -Exposure level

- Press the shutter button halfway and check the exposure level indicator.
- Turn the < >> dial to set the exposure compensation amount.
- You can set the amount up to ±5 stops in 1/3-stop increments.
- To cancel exposure compensation, set the exposure level indicator <■/ | > to the standard exposure index (< ▶/♥>).
- To set the exposure compensation while the < M > mode and Auto ISO are both set, refer to the camera's instruction manual.
- If the exposure compensation amount exceeds ±3 stops, setting it with the Quick Control screen is recommended.
 - You can also set it with the <**∑** > button and <**△** / > dial.
 - For light-colored subjects, set it to the plus side. For dark-colored subjects, set it to the minus side.

* AE Lock



- Focus the subject.
- Press the <★> button to lock the current exposure setting. The exposure level indicator on the right of the viewfinder will show the AE lock exposure level and the current exposure level in real-time.
- Recompose and take the picture.

Live View Shooting



- Select [4: LV ↑ / set.], then press < (SET) >.
- Select [Stills], then press < (ET)>.



Press the < > button to display the Live View image on the LCD monitor.



Press the <MODE> button and turn the < />
/) > dial to select the shooting mode.
