
EOS 5D Mark III

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Quick Start Guide

Insert the battery.



Insert a card.

The camera-front side slot is for a CF card, and the camera-back side slot is for an SD card.



Attach the lens.

Set the lens focus mode switch to <AF>.



Set the power switch

to <ON>.





- Set the Mode Dial to <P>
- The camera automatically sets the shutter speed and aperture in the same way as the < (A) > mode.

All the settings necessary for shooting are set automatically. You just press the shutter button, and the camera does the rest

- Aim the center of the Area AF frame over the subject.
- Press the shutter button halfway to focus.
- Check the display.
- Compose the shot and press the shutter button completely.
