WIRELESS MICROPHONE HEADSET AND AMPLIFIER CHARGING CORDS

It is recommended that you first charge both the Wireless Microphone Headset and Amplifier for at least 6 hours before using the first time.

Charge both after each use. If not used for a period of time, charge before using.

Features

Microphone

Charge and sync with amplifier before placing on head. See Power Switch Below.

As shown, wireless microphone is designed to be used on the left side of face. Place wire band around back of head, coming to rest just to the top of both ears.

Remove the foam windscreen. You can see the shape of the microphone. The front must be positioned in front of your mouth to work correctly. Replace the foam windscreen.

Front Microphone

Mini USB Connector—Charging

As previously mention, you want to charge your headset before using. Take the cord with the USB / mini USB connector and insert the mini USB plug into the connector on the wireless microphone headset. Insert the USB plug into the AC adapter connector and plug into AC outlet for charging. When charging, a red LED will light next to the volume + button. When fully charged, LED will turn off. It is now ready to use. When batteries are low the charging LED will begin to flash. Stop and charge.



Mini USB Connector


• Power Switch—Syncing to Amplifier

Turn both the amplifier and headset on. The headset will automatically sync with the amplifier. During the syncing process the charging LED will blink green. When the headset and amplifier are paired together the green LED will stop flashing and stay on. On the amplifier, a yellow LED will light up on the face of the amplifier and will stay on.



Volume

You can use the UP + and Down— buttons to either increase or lower the volume of the head set. For best performance, start with the amplifier volume at a low setting. Increase the volume first on the headset then on the amplifier.



TOP PANEL

Power ON / OFF Switch and Volume Control (1)

Rotate the dial in the direction of the word "ON" (+). The "BLUE" LED ② and "YELLOW" LED ③ will light to show that the amplifier is "ON". You can now pair the amplifier with the headset by turning on the headset. Headset will automatically pair. The headset GREEN LED should be ON and not flashing. Place headset on your head and speak into microphone. Adjust volume.

MP3 Slots—USB / Mini SD Card (TF) 4 5

Insert your Mini SD (TF) card or USB thumb drive into the appropriate slot / connector. "**BLUE**" LED will start to flash and start to play program material.

Press to STOP / PAUSE / PLAY program material.

Press to Advance to the next program material.

Press **4** 8 to **Go Back** to previous program material.

Press (short) "M" Mode ① to select between USB / TF (Mini SD) / AUX. Press and HOLD to start a LOOP (continuous) of program material.







SIDE PANEL

Charging Amplifier


Insert the barrel connector of the AC adapter into the DC 9V charging jack 10 of amplifier. Plug the AC adapter and into electrical outlet. The RED LED 11 will light and start to flash.

Audio Input (AUX)

This 1/8" (3.5mm) input connector (12) can be used for connecting to other devices such as cell phone, computer, or MP3/MP4 player.

Wired Microphone

This 1/8" (3.5mm) input connector (13) can be used for connecting a wired microphone. Both microphones can be used at the same time.



Take the adjustable strap and place around your waist. Adjust to your level of comfort. Case can be used on standard belt by removing web belt and inserting onto your standard belt.

Carry case is designed to fit tight around amplifier. Insert amplifier into case as shown.





PROBLEM & ITEMS TO CHECK

UNIT WILL NOT TURN ON

• Is the battery charged?

SOUND IS DISTORTED

• Turn down main volume

FEEDBACK: A LOUD SQUEALING, SHRILL OR HOWLING SOUND THAT IS SELF GENERATED

- Feedback occurs when a microphone is too close to the speaker or the microphone volume is too high, or the microphone is pointed towards the speaker. It is also caused by sound reflecting off hard surfaces.
- Reduce or eliminate Feedback by
 - Pointing the microphone in a different direction
 - Keeping the microphone BEHIND the speakers
 - Turn down the volume levels

POWER IS ON, BUT NO SOUND

- · Check volume levels
- If using wireless, be sure amplifier and/or transmitter battery is charged /or is on

MICROPHONE SIGNAL IS WEAK

· Check batteries

WIRELESS MIC DOES NOT WORK

• Check transmitter to ensure transmitter is on.

WIRELESS MIC CUTS IN AND OUT

• Is unit visible (line of sight) from user? If not, move unit into view when using wireless microphone.
