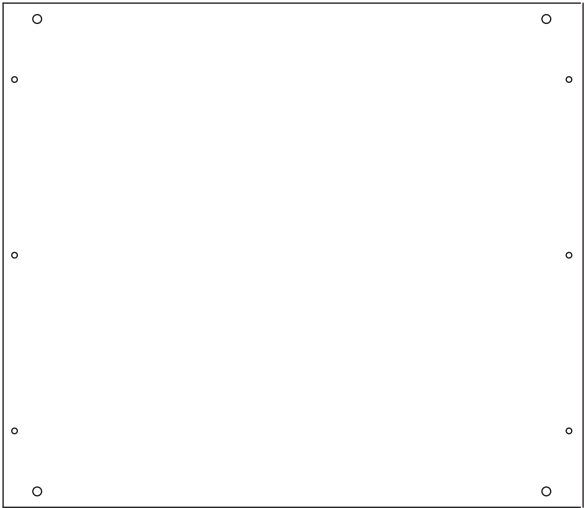

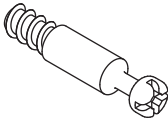

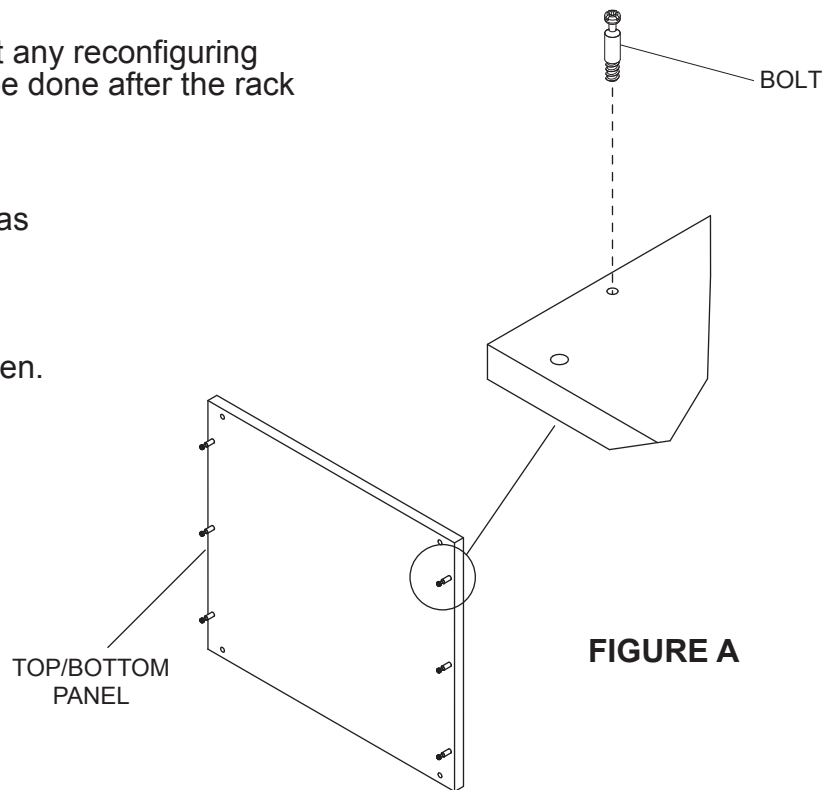

ASSEMBLY

NOTE: It is recommended that any reconfiguring or addition of rackrail be done after the rack is assembled.

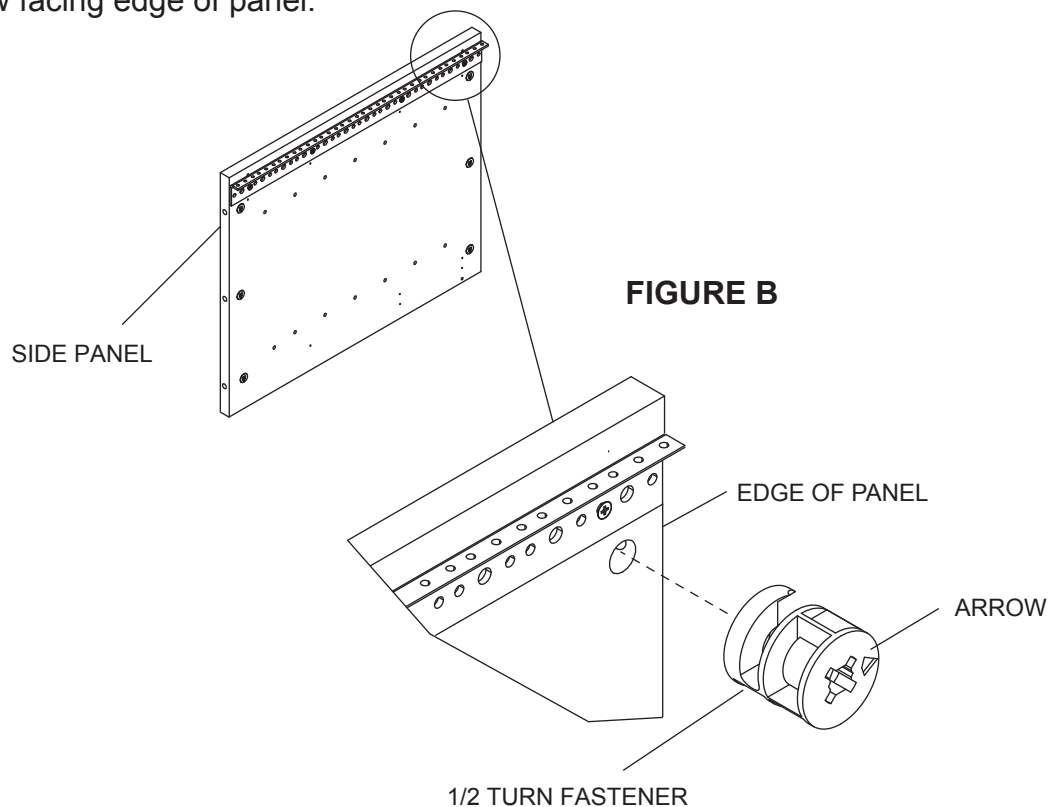
- 1) Using a screwdriver, install bolts to top/bottom panels as shown. (See **FIGURE A**)

CAUTION: Do Not Over Tighten.



- 2) Install 1/2 turn fasteners into sides as shown. (See **FIGURE B**)

NOTE: 1/2 turn fasteners must be installed with arrow facing edge of panel.



ASSEMBLY (Continued)

- 3) For ease of assembly, install one side panel and one top/bottom panel as shown. (See **FIGURE C**) Turn 1/2 turn fasteners clockwise to tighten.

NOTE: Do Not Over Tighten.

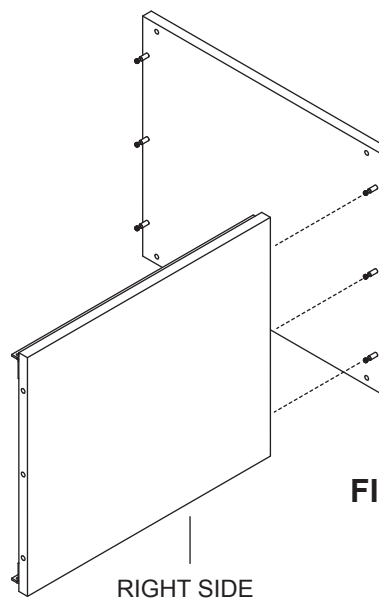

- 4) Assemble rest of rack as shown (See **FIGURE D**). Turn 1/2 turn fasteners clockwise to tighten.

NOTE: Do Not Over Tighten

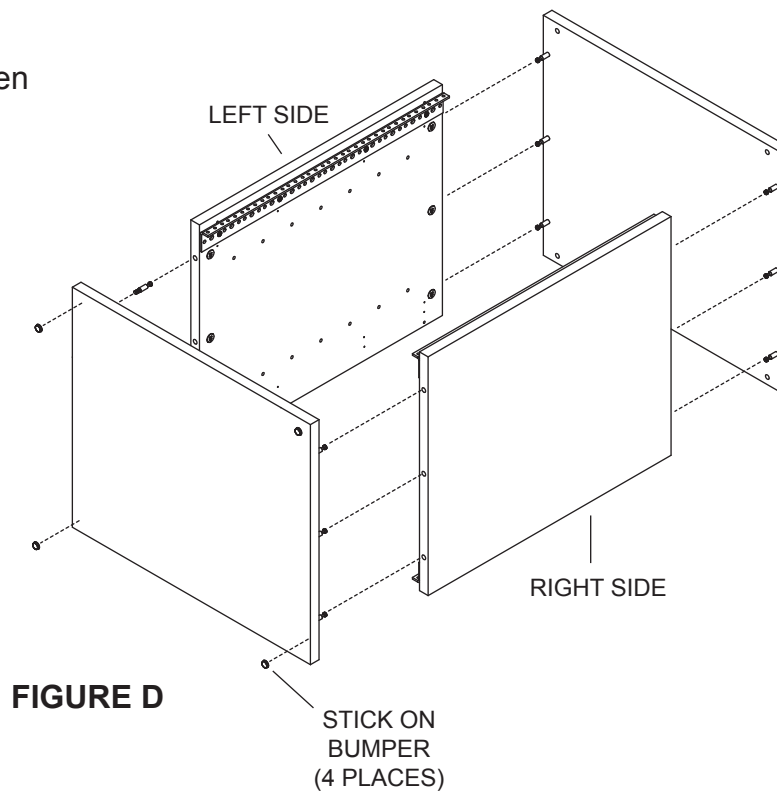

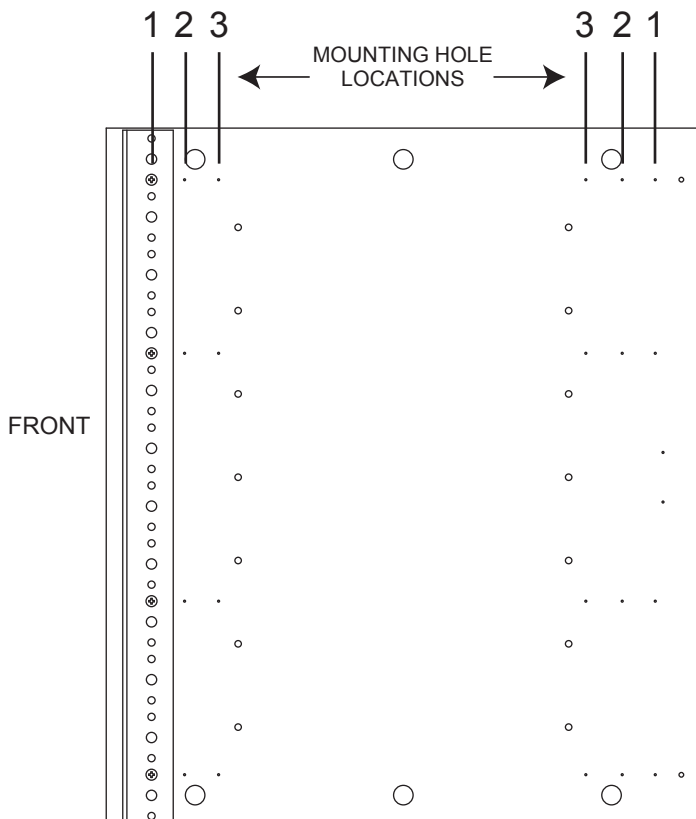
- 5) Install stick-on bumpers if not using optional casters.
- 6) Assembly of rack is completed. Options and additional rackrails can now be installed.



DETERMINE OPTIONS BEFORE CONTINUING

- Casters, Part # - RKW
- Quick-Position™ Shelf, Part # - SH-BRK (Cannot be installed with front or rear rackrail in the 3rd setback location - see below)
- Power Strip, refer to our catalog or middleatlantic.com for a complete listing
- Rear rackrail, Part # - RK-RRxx
- Smoked, tempered glass door, Part # - RK-GDxx
- Rear Access Panel, Part # - RK-RAPxx (Not available for 6 space racks)
- 100 CFM DC Fan Kit, Part # - DCFANKIT-4.

1) Determine rail mounting requirements. The front rackrail comes pre-installed in mounting location 1.



- If the Door (RK-GDxx) and the Rear Access Panel (RK-RAPx) are not being used, the front and rear rackrail can be installed in any one of the three mounting locations.

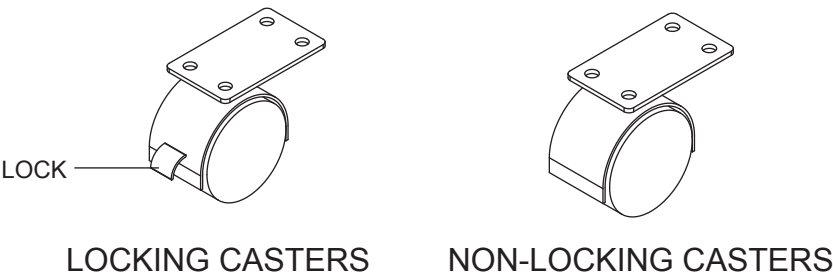
- If the Door (RK-GDxx) and the Rear Access Panel (RK-RAPx) are being used, the front rackrail must be installed in location two and the rear rackrail must be installed in location three.

TIP: When moving the front rackrail to the setback position, relocate and mount the rail on the opposite side of the panel to obscure the 1st set of mounting holes.

OPTIONS

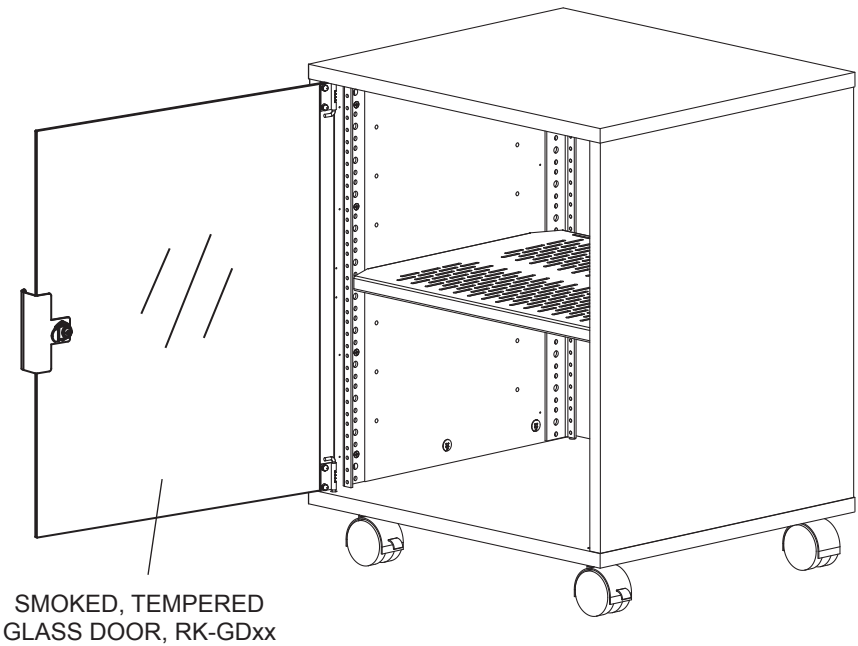
Casters create a portable rack that locks in place, part # RKW.



Rear rackrail (RK-RRxx) for equipment support and cable management.



Smoked tempered glass door secures components and enhances appearance, part # RK-GDxx.

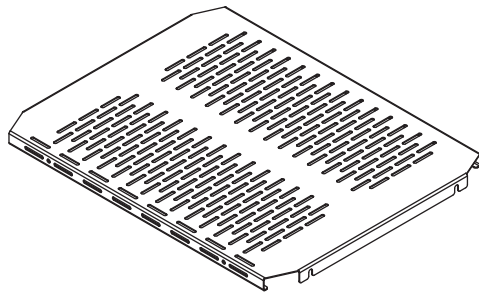


OPTIONS

Quick-Position™ Shelf mounts without rack screws and accepts rear mounting of power strip, part # SH-BRK.

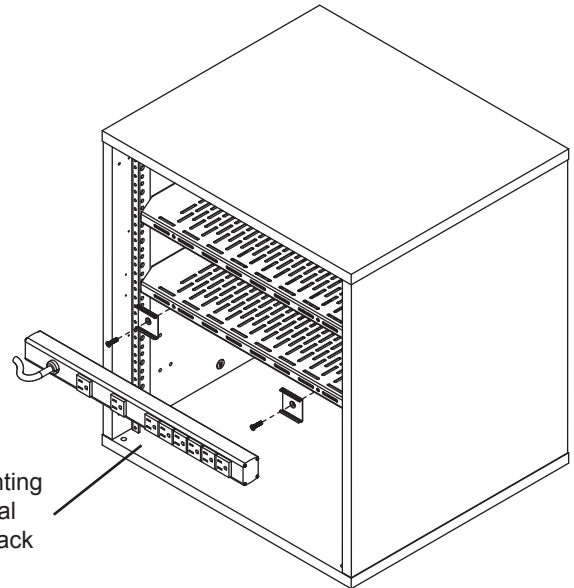
NOTE: Shelves can be used with or without rackrail installed.

NOTE: Rear Access Pan cannot be used if installing a power strip to the shelf.



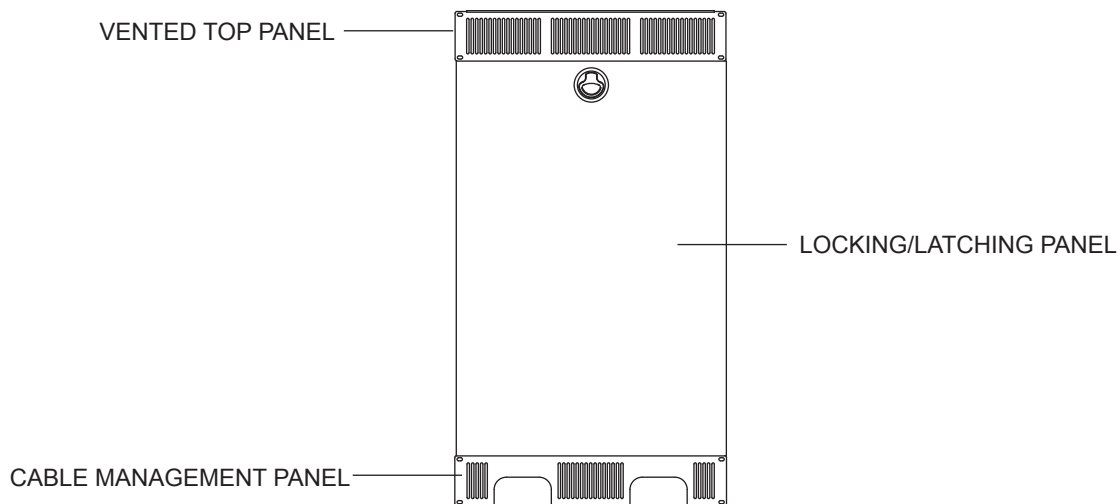

PD-815SC-NS POWER STRIP SHOWN (When mounting power strip to shelf, optional rear rackrail must be in setback position).

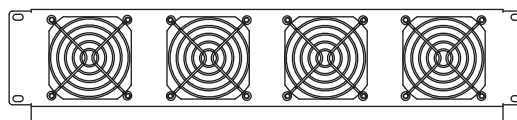


REAR VIEW
