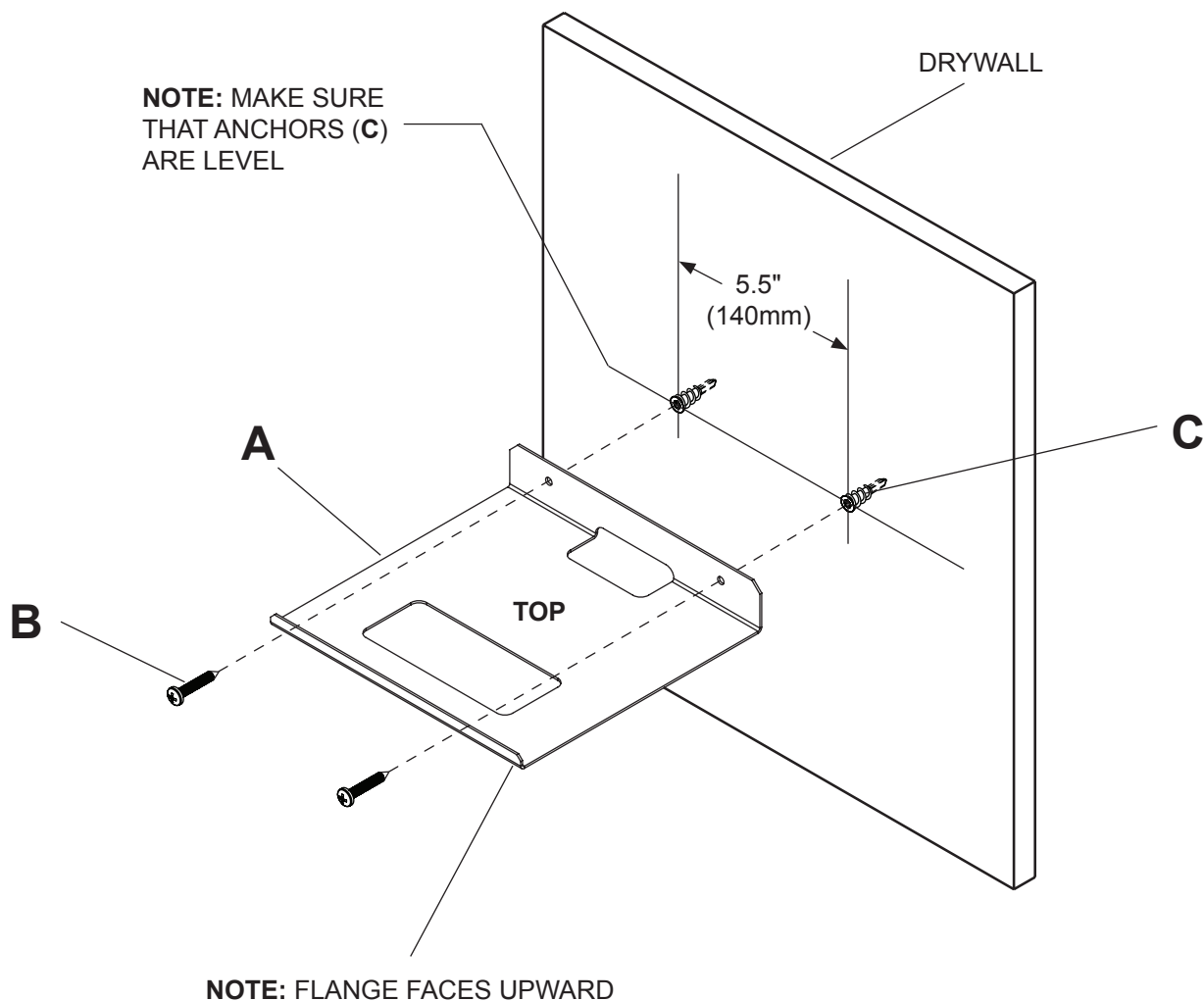


Installation to Drywall

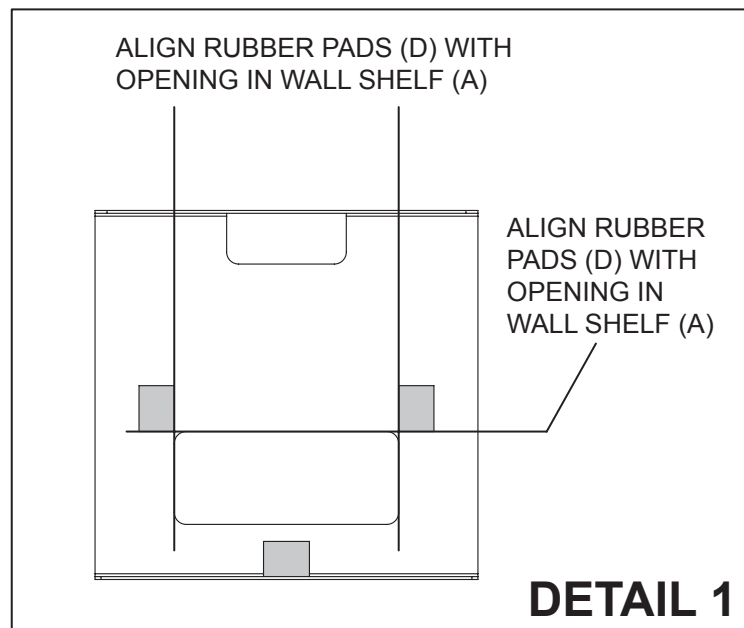
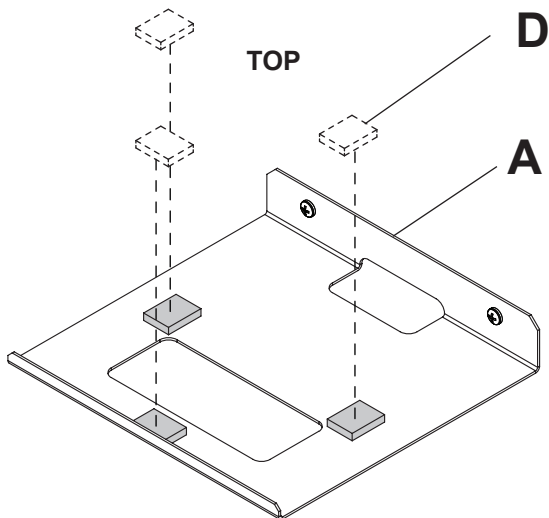
! WARNING

- Drywall must be 1/2" or thicker.
- Make sure that the wall will safely support the combined load of the equipment and all attached hardware and components.
- Using a power drill to secure anchors may cause anchors to fail.

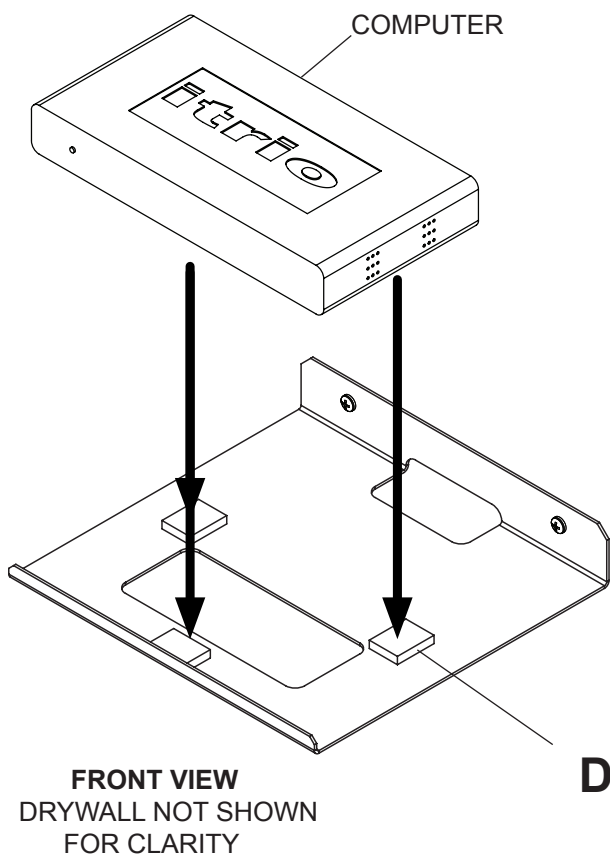
- 1** **NOTE:** Flange on wall shelf faces upward.
Using wall shelf (A) as a template, mark the center of the two mounting holes. Using a phillips screwdriver, install two anchors (C) into drywall as shown below.
Loosely fasten wall shelf (A) to drywall using two #8 x 1" phillips head screws (D).
Level, hold, and then tighten all screws.



- 2** **NOTE:** Rubber pads must be in orientation as shown in detail 1.
Place three rubber pads (**D**) onto top surface of wall shelf in orientation as shown in detail 1.



- 3** Place computer on top of rubber pads (**D**) as shown below.



- 4** Route computer cables through opening as shown. **NOTE:** Cable ties (**E**) can be used as needed.
