
KickPlate[™] boundary mic isolator



OVERVIEW


The KickPlate is an isolating platform designed for those who employ boundary microphones like the popular Shure[®] Beta91A inside the bass drum. The KickPlate features a dual pontoon isolation base that allows it to be used in kick drums of all sizes. This isolates the microphone from the vibrations.



A heavy steel platform provides a stable microphone mounting surface. This is topped with a no-slip Neoprene pad to keep the microphone in place.




For those who travel, four cut-out slots provide tie-down points to help hold the KickPlate firmly in place. This can be attached to the inside lugs of the bass drum using heavy wire. Once in place the KickPlate will help reduce resonance and noise from the drum hardware entering the mic.




STUDIO SET-UP

Simply place the KickPlate inside the drum shell and position the microphone on the no-slip top pad. The image below shows the KickPlate inside a bass drum with a Beta 91A. Move the KickPlate further in or out of the shell to find the best balance and tone.



LIVE SETUP

If you intend to travel with the KickPlate attached inside the drum shell, make sure it is well secured and checked regularly to ensure it will not dislodge. The heavy plate can damage the drum if not properly attached. Pass a wire through the tie-down slots and wrap it around itself at least four times. At the other end, loosen the drum hardware so the wire can wrap around the bolt. Re-tighten the hardware and your good to go!
