

Artwork Requirements for UV Printing

ARTWORK REQUIREMENTS

All artwork for the UV Printer must be submitted in Vector format or high resolution Raster format.

Vector artwork must be submitted as an AI or EPS (Adobe Illustrator) or Vector PDF (Adobe Acrobat).

- All text (fonts) must be converted to outlines
- All artwork must be in CMYK
- Embed any linked images

Note: Changing the file name to a vector file extension will not change the file type.

Raster artwork must be submitted as a TIFF, JEPG, or PNG with a transparent background.


 All artwork must be 300dpi or higher at the size it will be printed

Note: If printing in white ink, vector artwork is required



How to Convert Text (Fonts) to Outlines

If working in Illustrator or other graphic programs, you will want to convert your text to outlines prior to sending the file. To do this, you will want to go up to the menus at the top of the Illustrator program. Click on "Type" and go down to "Create Outlines."

Raster vs Vector

Raster files are made up of pixels and are commonly called bitmaps. Vector files use coordinates to create shapes with points and lines. This file type maintains high image quality at any size.
